**IWANT YOU:** to support our Star Families –. Do not forget to observe GOLD STAR MOTHERS AND FAMILIES' DAY – Last Sunday in September to show your gratitude and respect for our Gold Star Mothers & Families!! Your Auxiliary is encouraged to recognize and honor these families in your community!

**I WANT YOU**: to host or attend a POW/MIA Recognition Day Ceremony – traditionally the third Friday of September and honors the commitments and the sacrifices made by our nation's prisoners of war and those who are still missing in action. Patriotic Instructor

Your job is a vital one to our organization and keeping its traditions. Remember, the freedoms we enjoy today and take for granted are constantly at risk. Our freedom is in place only because of the sacrifices of our military heroes, the men and women who served and are still serving.

As a Patriotic Instructor, you must instruct our auxiliary members on how they are to stand at attention; the proper way to salute; the recitation of The Pledge of Allegiance; and what parade rest means. And we must make the Public aware of upcoming patriotic holidays and events.

New members often feel they are left out and do not know exactly what to do. It is your job as Patriotic Instructor to help them feel comfortable by sharing with them a copy of the "Understanding Auxiliary Traditions" The video is also available on the website at

vfwauxiliary.org/resources. You should take to time to understand the VFW Auxiliary Ritual and Bylaws and the Federal Flag Code.

As Patriotic Instructor, you will take part in your auxiliary meetings and recite the following:

"Let us be ever mindful of our duties as members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States Auxiliary, to see that our flag is never desecrated and to teach the people of this land what that means and to see that all are instructed in the Pledge to the Flag."
