These are activities that are not reportable: Personal Donations to Programs or other organizations, personal visits to Military bases, personal service in other organizations, working in the Post bar, working, cleaning, cooking, serving at Post Functions, planning sessions for functions. You also do not need to report activities that are reported in other programs to Veterans & Family Support.

I do know that some parts of our program are individualized such as Caregivers activities or supporting families dealing with veteran suicide but not all activities you do are reportable items.
