Honors Escort

As part of the end-of-life protocol for veterans who pass away while in facility care. The Honors Escort is an opportunity to honor each veteran in a respectful and open manner and provides a way for the veteran's family and friends, other veterans and staff to participate in a display of high regard and reverence for the individual at the time of death.

Community Care

- > Care through local, in-network providers outside the VA medical facilities
 - > See your VA doctor and request to see an outside provider.
 - > Once approved, you may proceed to schedule your appointment, or the VA can schedule the appointment for you.
 - > After your appointment is scheduled, your authorization is created.
 - > Attend the scheduled appointment or appointments.
 - > Reauthorization may be needed for care beyond the limits of your authorization.
 - Prescriptions and durable medical equipment can be filled\provided at a VA medical facility pharmacy.
 - Based on your disability rating and your private insurance, you may owe a copay for services.

Telehealth & Compassionate Contact

- Clinical Video Telehealth Services are health-related services which allow long distance patients to receive services conveniently, securely and quickly with access to health care services from remote facilities and homes.
- Compassionate Contact Corps comprises trained volunteers who are matched with veterans who are experiencing loneliness or are socially isolated. Volunteers typically call on veterans and family members to assist with socializing and providing companionship via phone or video calls.

Women's Health Care

As the fastest-growing veteran population in the VA system, women need and want health care they can count on. While the VA system has come a long way, the opportunity to utilize the Community Care system for health care specific to women is priceless.
