It's up to you to chat up a storm about our organization and show enthusiasm about who we are, what we do and why we do it. Invite more members to be those talent scouts."

We all have different capes to wear.

- Treasurer's need to make sure that the applications are filled out correctly.
- Investigating committees need to make sure our new heroes qualify and that the applications are filled out correctly with their signatures.
- Secretary's need to call the new member and let them know they have been excepted
- Presidents should call and invite the new members within a week with the next meeting and to be initiated and given a pin and a by-law book, call and check back with them.

We need to invite them to functions. Ask if there is something that they would love to help in. Some would love to help at the VA while other's love to work at schools with Scholarships. Give them a Welcome packet located in Malta under Resources and click on membership. You can get information on New Member Welcome Kits, VFW Auxiliary Traditions, and much more helpful tips.

Have a Plan every Auxiliary should have a Membership Plan. This plan should include:

- Contacting current members
- Outreach to former members
- Recruiting events for new members.
- Picking a mentor for a new member.
- Before a membership year begins, set your calendar for these events:
- Make it as easy as possible for members to renew their dues. They can renew online in MALTA

- Plan at least four recruiting events in your community each year.
- Plan to Mail out your due reminders out in July. Do an Early Bird Special- Vote on paying for 1 Life Membership out of all the annual members who pay by September. You'll be amazed on how many are willing to pay early.
