Whew, I almost made the error of using an acronym for the Past Department Presidents (PDP) and then I realized #MoreThan Letters, not acronyms, as our National Ambassador, Linda so eloquently proposed in her first promotion. So, I went back and corrected it. For several years I thought that "PDP" referred to Past District Presidents and one day a Past Department President very kindly corrected me. I tell you this actual story to show that even we, as tribe members, don't always know what an acronym stands for.



You might recall that in my last promotion I stated that I would try to describe the term #AuxTRIBE. I will try to do so here. A tribe is a connection of commons ideals, objects language, etc. We often think of tribes being associated with the American Indian. However, Linda would prefer that we think of the tribe in terms of our auxiliaries and members of the military. When one thinks about it, it makes perfect sense. Auxiliaries have one common goal, to serve our veterans. After boot camp a recruit either goes to a school or is assigned to a unit and makes new friends. These become their "TRIBE." Not having served in a foreign war I can only imagine how close buddies become, after all one depends on this person to cover their backs. Then at some point, if one is lucky, they are released and sent home. One is a new and different person. He or she leaves buddies behind and is basically left to fend for themselves.
