While the cut off for this year's reporting is drawing near, that doesn't mean the work is stopping.....

Next month is the Month of the Military Child sponsored by the Department of Defense. The purpose is to recognize the sacrifices of military children and their families, to build college and career readiness for students and to challenge students to excel academically, socially, emotionally and physically.

The official flower of the military child is the dandelion because, like dandelions, Military children can take root and flourish practically anywhere the wind blows them.

Here are some ways you can celebrate/raise awareness/help....

- 1) You can show your support for Military Children by wearing purple on Purple Up! Day on April 15th or any day in April. Why Purple? Purple is the combination of all the colors (blue, green and red) of the US Armed Forces.
- 2) Hold a breakfast/lunch or similar event for military children and their families.
- 3) Hold a crafting event or similar for local military children.
- 4) Learn about the issues military children face.
- 5) Adopt a family of a deployed military member.
- 6) Hold a food drive for military families.
- 7) Ask your local schools if they have any events planned that you can help with.
- 8) Offer to be a mentor or a tutor for a student.
- 9) Use Hashtags when posting pictures of related events #MOMC, #MonthoftheMilitaryChild, #PurpleUp.

10) Share facts about military-connected children to raise awareness.		

Did you know that, as of 2024:

- 1. There are more than 1.6 million military children
 - a. 0-5 years old: 399,176 active duty, 204,405 reserve
 - b. 6-11 years old: 312,460 active duty, 211,136 reserves
 - c. 12-18 years old: 214,049 active duty, 177.166 reserve
 - d. 19-22 years old: 38,800 active duty, 64,281 reserves
- 2. 80% of military children in the K-12 age range attend public schools
- 3. Since 2001, more than 2 million American children have had a parent deployed at least once
- 4. Military families move every two to three years on average
- 5. Military children change schools an average of six to nine times from the start of kindergarten to their high school graduation.

6. Military children are twice as likely to join the military when they become adults
