Not only does this help a member but it also helps the Auxiliary in the long run. The more Life members you have the more money you receive back for having Life Members, but you also win each year the monies from National awards and State awards for being 100% early. So it's a win - win for you! You will be amazed by how many will pay their Early Bird dues.

#### Now there's Team Work!!!

- . <u>Members</u> need to not be shy and ask wherever they are, strike up a conversation. "How are you today? Hey, I'm a part of this Great Organization that helps Veterans. Have you ever had a family member that served in a War?" You'll be surprised how many have and how many didn't know that they could join. Get off your ASK and ASK ♥
- . <u>Treasurers</u> need to make sure that the applications are filled out correctly.
- . <u>Investigating committees</u> need to make sure our new potential member qualifies and that the applications are filled out correctly with their signatures and birth dates.
- . Secretaries need to call the new member and let them know they have been accepted
- . <u>Presidents</u> should call and invite the new members within a week with the next meeting and to be initiated and given a pin and a Bylaw book, call and check back with them.
- . <u>Invite</u> them to functions. Ask if there is something that they would love to help with. Some would love to help at the VA while others love to work at schools with Scholarships. Give them a Welcome packet located in MALTA under Resources and click on membership. You can get information on New Member Welcome Kits, and helpful tips.

Department Treasurer must enter membership in MALTA with credit given to the recruiter by June 10, 2025. National Membership Award to be presented at the 2025 National Convention in Columbus, OH. If a member is not in attendance, the award to be mailed directly to the member from National Headquarters after National convention.
- 3. **VFW Auxiliary Recruiter Drawing.** Each VFW Auxiliary National Membership Achievement Award recipient will be entered into a drawing o receive a \$500 Visa Gift Cards. (VFW Recruiters are not eligible).

Recruiter Award Forms are no longer needed for VFW Auxiliary members. Reports are compiled by VFW Auxiliary National headquarters from information entered in MALTA.

VFW members who recruit new VFW Auxiliary members will need to fill out the required VFW members-only form that is available on MALTA Member Resources. Completed form must be received at VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters and Department Treasurer must enter membership in MALTA by June 10, 2025.

#### **National Awards for Auxiliaries:**

- 1. \$25 to each Auxiliary that reaches 98% Plus in Membership by March 31, 2025\*
- 2. \$25 to each Auxiliary that reaches 100% Plus in Membership by June 30, 2025.\*
- 3. VFW Auxiliary Drawing. Each VFW Auxiliary that reaches 101% Plus by June 30, 2025\* will be entered into a onetime drawing to receive \$500.

#### **National Awards for Department Chairman:**

- 1. \$25 VFW Store gift certificate to one Department Membership Chairman in each of the 10 Program Divisions for the most outstanding training and promotion of the Membership Program.

#### **ALL-STATE AUXILIARY PRESIDENT CRITERIA**

To qualify for All-State Auxiliary President Award, the following criteria **must** be met.

- 1. The Auxiliary must be 100% in Membership by March 31, 2025.
- 2. The Auxiliary <u>must</u> be represented by at least the Auxiliary President, Senior Vice President or Junior Vice President at <u>all</u> District meetings and Schools of Instruction. It is recommended that your program chairman attend these meetings as often as possible.
- 3. All Auxiliary audits must be current.
- 4. The Auxiliary <u>must</u> attain <u>100% participation and reporting</u> in Americanism, Hospital & Veterans & Family Support Programs.
- 5. The Auxiliary <u>must</u> hold at least 10 business meetings per year. Monthly business meetings are encouraged. A quorum of five members is required at each meeting. (Section 210 and 212 in the National Bylaws).
- 6. All quotas must be paid by December 31, 2025.
- 7. Your application for All-State Auxiliary President <u>must be received</u> by the Department Membership Chairman by April 15, 2025.

#### **ALL-STATE DISTRICT PRESIDENT CRITERIA**

To qualify for All-State District President award, the following criteria must be met:

- 1. District <u>must</u> be 100% in Membership by March 31, 2025.
- 2. The District President must attend at least two (2) Council of Administration meetings.
- 3. The District <u>must</u> attain <u>100% participation and reporting</u> in Americanism, Hospital & Veterans & Family Support Programs.
- 4. All Auxiliary and District audits must be current.
- 5. All inspections of Auxiliaries in your District <u>must</u> be completed and reported to the Department office by January 10, 2025.
- 6. You must hold at least (2) District Meetings in the 2024-2025 year.
- 7. The District President's report <u>must be received</u> by the Department Membership Chairman by April 15, 2025.

All-State Auxiliary and All-State District Presidents will receive a citation of accomplishment and a name badge, which identifies the individual as an All-State President.
