- Recruiter Award Forms are no longer needed for VFW Auxiliary members.
 Reports are compiled by VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters from information entered in MALTA.
- Pin to each VFW and VFW Auxiliary member who recruits five (5) new members to the VFW Auxiliary from July 1, 2024 through May 31, 2025. Department Treasurer must enter membership in MALTA with credit given to the recruiter by June 10, 2025 -- pin will be mailed directly to the member from National Headquarters.
- National Membership Achievement Award to each VFW and VFW Auxiliary member who
 recruits twenty (20) new members to the VFW Auxiliary from July 1, 2024 through May
 31, 2025. Department Treasurer must enter membership in MALTA with credit given to
 the recruiter by June 10, 2025. Award to be presented at the 2025 National Convention.
 If a member is not in attendance, the award to be mailed directly to the member from
 National Headquarters after National Convention.
- There is a New All-American Application for California's Presidents to be filed out by April 15th.
