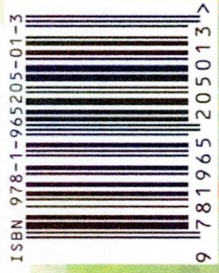

A light-hearted series perfect for young readers, with short chapters to ensure a sense of accomplishment.



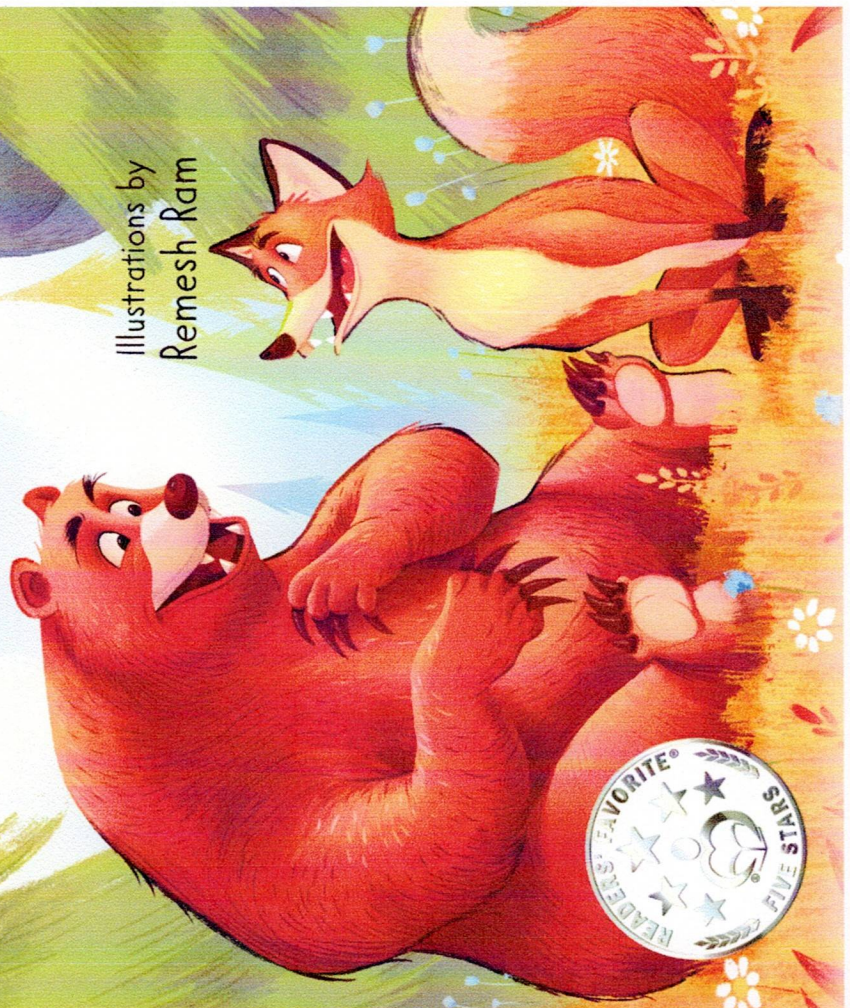

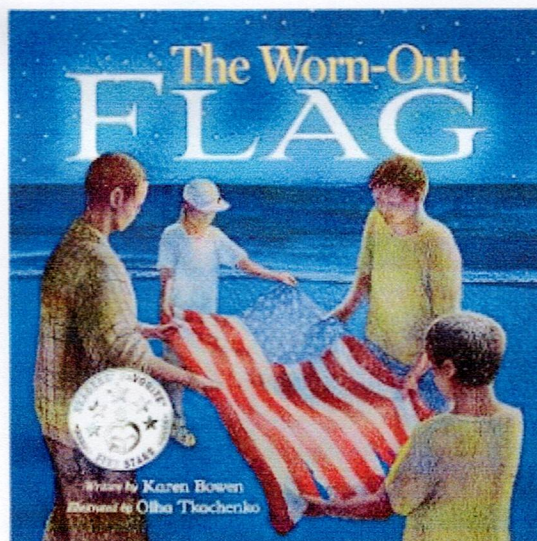
