#### **Award Details:**

- **Citation and \$25 Prize**: One VFW Auxiliary in each of the 10 Program Divisions will receive a Citation and a \$25 prize.
- **Recognition**: Citations will be mailed directly to the winning Auxiliaries from National Headquarters.
- **Prize Disbursement**: The \$25 prize will be deposited into the winning Auxiliary's account after the 2025 VFW Auxiliary National Convention.

#### **Entry Instructions:**

- **Submission Deadline**: Completed entry forms must be sent to the Department Legislative Chairman by March 31, 2025.
- **Judging Criteria**: The entries will be judged based on the outstanding nature of the activity/event and the effectiveness in connecting members with local lawmakers.

Participating in this award program not only brings recognition and financial rewards to your Auxiliary but also demonstrates your commitment to advocacy and community engagement. This is a wonderful chance to highlight your Auxiliary's efforts and build
