- We can contribute to the Department's Emergency/Assistance/Disaster Fund. The monies
 donated to this fund are used to help our sisters and brothers in California Auxiliaries when
 they are impacted by floods, fires or other catastrophes. If you are in need of assistance, the
 Grant Application form can be found under the members only section of the Department's
 website.
- We can do welfare checks on members who live in the impacted areas and reach out to see if any help can be provided. They may need help with clothing, temporary accommodation or even providing for family pets.
- We can donate money or goods to any VFW Posts/Auxiliaries or local groups that organize
 drives to assist those who may be unhoused or in need. We can also make ourselves
 available to help those groups in their efforts.

I am certain that you can come up with many other ways to help and I look forward to hearing about What your Auxiliaries do in your reports.

Just before the holidays I was privileged to be able to meet with some Student Veterans from a local college. As a group they were keen to become involved with VFW activities and many were eligible to join either the VFW Posts or the Auxiliary. It was great to be around such enthusiasm and energy! I look forward to working with them in the future and hopefully welcoming them in to our VFW/Auxiliary family.

Many student veterans are trying to juggle family needs, work and study and have limited incomes. If you get the opportunity here are some ways you might be able to help

- Tell them about the financial assistance they can get from the VFW (more info can be found at https://www.vfw.org/asssitance/student-veterans-support)
 - The Sport Clips Help a Hero Scholarship, up to \$5,000 is available to any service member or veteran to help them complete their educational goals.
- Host an outreach event designed to assist and support veterans currently enrolled in institutions of higher learning that aren't affiliated with a Student Veterans of America (SVA).

- You can apply for a VFW Student Veteran Support Grant of up to \$500 to do that. (more info can be found at https://www.vfw.org/asssitance/student-veterans-support)
- Share information about the VFW-SVA Legislative Fellowship which grants exemplary students the chance to join the VFW Legislative team on Capitol Hill during the VFW Legislative Conference in early Spring ((more info can be found at https://www.vfw.org/asssitance/student-veterans-support)
- Your Auxiliary could help sponsor a local member of the SVA to attend the SVA National Conference each year
- Your Post/Auxiliary might be able to provide meeting or event space for Student's to host events of their own
- You can
 - o provide food or diapers for distribution at your local Student Veterans Resource center.
 - You can share information with the students about what benefits they may be entitled to and how to go about getting help and resources.
 - You can invite the students to participate in your activities and events and make them feel a part of our family.

Finally, as a reminder, the date to submit your application for the Veterans and Family Support Award for 2024-5 is fast approaching.

This year the award of a citation and \$25 will be given to one auxiliary in each of the 10 program divisions, for the most outstanding activity and/or event to increase awareness of suicide and mental health for veterans, military and their families.
