
Hello VFW Auxiliary Department of California,

December 1st Civil Air Patrol Birthday

The U.S. Air Force Auxiliary observes its birthday on this day. The Civil Air Patrol (CAP) was founded on December 1, 1941, and this is celebrated as its birthday. The organization serves as the official civilian auxiliary of the U.S. Air Force and has evolved from its initial mission of mobilizing civilian aviation for national defense.



Dec. 7 – National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day

This day is observed to remember the attack on Pearl Harbor in 1941, which led to the United States entry into World War II. Events often include flag ceremonies, and the day is sometime designated for flying the flag half-mast.



Bill of Rights Day is celebrated annually on December 15 to commemorate the ratification of the first ten amendments to the U.S. Constitution in 1791. The day honors the fundamental rights and freedoms, such as freedom of speech, press, and religion, that are guaranteed to Americans and serves as a reminder of the importance of the Bill of Rights. It is not a national holiday, but is observed with various activities and ceremonies. In 1941, President Franklin D. Roosevelt designated this day to celebrate the adoption of the U.S. Bill of Rights.



The National Guard's birthday in 2025 is on Saturday, December 13, 2025. This date marks the 389th anniversary of the organization's founding in 1636, when the first militia regiments were organized in Massachusetts.
