Continuing Education

This scholarship is available to Auxiliary members (for at least a year), their spouses and children. This is the only scholarship limited by membership. The applicant must be 21 years of age or older to qualify.

The Continuing Education Scholarship is \$1,250 and is awarded to one winner in each of the four Conferences. This scholarship will be paid directly to the American college or vocational/technical school of the awardee's choice.

Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest (YACPAC)

The Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest now offers 19 National scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$15,000. This two-dimensional creative contest is available to applicants in grades 9-12 and a legal U.S. Resident. Brochures and applications are available in MALTA under Member Resources.

- 2-Dimensional entry rules:
- Must be on canvas or heavy paper.
- Watercolor, pencil, pastel, charcoal, tempera, crayon, acrylic, pen, ink, oil, marker or other medial may be used.
- Must be completed during the current school year.
- Submit canvas entries on stretcher frame or canvas board. If matted, must be matted in white. Do Not Use Color mats.
- Do Not frame art. Reinforce the back with heavy paper. Mounted & floating mats may be used.
- Complete & submit contest entry form. Parent or guardian signature required if under the age of 18.
- Entries may not be smaller than 8" x10" and not larger than 18" x 24" (not including mat).
- Complete typed explanation of art, 250 words or less by the artist.
- If the American flag is used, it must conform to the Federal Flag Code in relation to colors, number of stars and stripes and other pertinent rules of the code.
- Digital art and photography are NOT accepted.

3-Dimensional Patriotic Art Contest

This contest is available to all patriotic young artists in grades 9-12 and a legal U.S. Resident, Four National scholarships are available: \$2,500 for 1st place, \$1,500 for 2nd place, \$1,000 for 3rd place and \$500 for 4th place.

- 3-Dementional art accepts paper, paper-mâché, fabric, metalwork, pottery, wood, etc. Brochures and applications are available in MALTA under Member Resources.
- 3-Dimensional entry rules:
- ***NEW REQUIREMENT*** Entries must have a photo taken of them before they are mailed and photo must accompany the art piece to National.
- Must be three dimensional.
- Must be completed during the school year.
- May be paper, papier mâché, pottery, fabric, wood, metal, sculpture, etc.
- Typed explanation of steps taken to create art along with 250-words-or-less statement.
- Completed entry form with parent or guardian signature if artist is under the age of 18.
- If American flag is used, it must conform to the Federal Flag Code.

- Entries may not be larger than 18" in any direction.
- May not weigh more than 5 pounds.
- Digital art, photography, 3-D laser printed art, weapons & jewelry NOT accepted.
