How to Notify the VFW Auxiliary about a Deceased Member

- You can call VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters at 816.561.8655 and talk to a staff member in our Membership Department who's ready to help.
- You are welcome to send us an email at info@vfwauxiliary.org instead of calling. Please put "Deceased Member" in the subject line. Your message should include the name and address of the deceased, and the membership number. Please include your name, your relationship to the deceased member, and your e-mail address or home address.
- You may send a note or a completed Membership Update Form by standard U.S. mail to the address below. Please include the same information listed above under the e-mail instructions. You can also fax this information to VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters at 816.931.4753.
